We hope to see you on the course!

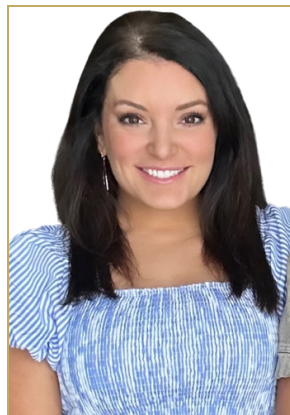

Advocacy
